## Land Acknowledgement

The Portland Metro area rests on traditional village sites of the Multnomah, Wasco, Cowlitz, Kathlamet, Clackamas, Bands of Chinook, Tualatin, Kalapuya, Molalla, and many other tribes who made their homes along the Columbia River. #### **Artist Check In**

## Friday, September 1

Please check in at the Information Booth before you set up. The Info Booth opens at 10am Friday and is located on the north side of NW Everett St between NW Park Ave & 8th Ave This is where you will pick up your artist packet and parking pass (if you purchased one). There will be complimentary water available during setup. Portable toilets will be available for artists during setup as well. Please be kind to our volunteers and traffic directors!

#### Load In

## Friday, September 1

Load in times are based on your booth location. See included map. PLEASE arrive during your load in time window; otherwise, you may encounter difficulties accessing the site. There will be 3 checkpoints (A, B, and C) for arriving artists to enter the site. Look for the volunteers in orange vests to greet you. They will issue a Load In pass to keep visible on your vehicle dash while unloading and will direct you to your space. Please unload everything you need and move your vehicle off site as quickly as possible to ensure that everyone has a chance to set up before dark. We thank you for your cooperation and wish you a successful show!

## Checkpoint A (NW Davis St & NW Park Ave)

## 10am - 12pm:

#### Booths S20-S38

Enter from NW 9th Ave heading east on NW Davis St, turn left (north) onto NW Park Ave. Unload on NW Park Ave and then move your vehicle. *Exit by turning right* (east) onto NW Everett St.

#### Booths S46-S61

Enter from NW 9th Ave heading east on NW Davis St, turn Left (north) onto NW 8th Ave. Unload on NW 8th Ave and then move your vehicle. *Exit by turning right (east) on NW Everett St.* 

## Checkpoint A Cont. (NW Davis St & NW Park Ave)

## 1:30pm - 3pm:

#### Booths S01-S19

Enter from NW 9th Ave heading east on NW Davis St, turn left (north) onto NW Park Ave. Unload on NW Park Ave and then move your vehicle. *Exit by turning right* (east) on NW Everett St.

#### Booths S62-S78

Enter from NW 9th Ave heading east on NW Davis St, turn left (north) onto NW 8th Ave. Unload on NW 8th Ave and then move your vehicle. *Exit by turning right (east)* on NW Everett St.

#### 3pm - 5pm:

#### Booths S39-S45

Enter from NW 9th Ave heading east on NW Davis St. Unload on NW Davis St and then move your vehicle. *Exit by turning right on NW 8th Ave.* 

### Checkpoint B (NW Park Ave & NW Flanders St)

#### 10am - 12pm:

#### **Booths N97-N112**

Enter from NW Park Ave heading south. Unload on NW Park Ave and then move your vehicle before setting up. Exit by turning left (east) on NW Everett St.

## 2pm - 4pm:

#### **Booths N79 - N96**

Enter from NW Park Ave heading south. Unload on NW Park Ave and then move your vehicle before setting up. *Exit by turning left (east) on NW Everett St.* 

## Checkpoint C (NW Flanders St & NW 8th Ave)

#### 10am - 12pm:

#### **Booths N113-N125**

Enter from NW Broadway heading west on NW Flanders St. Turn left (south) on 8th Ave. Unload on NW 8th Ave and then move your vehicle before setting up. *Exit by turning left (east) on to NW Everett St.* 

## **Parking**

A limited number of first come, first served parking spaces will be available for purchase through ZAPP August 1-15. Parking spaces will be assigned and the parking pass will be in your artist packet at check-in. *These purchased parking spaces will be available on SHOW DAYS ONLY (Saturday, Sunday, Monday), not during set-up on Friday.* 

If you did not purchase a parking pass, there are other parking options. Monday is a holiday, so street parking is free that day. See the *Off-Site Parking Map* for nearby street parking and lots.

Morning restocks are fine; just make sure all vehicles are off site by 9:30am. Remember, no vehicles on the grass!!

## **Electricity**

Purchase electricity on Zapp by August 15 for the \$95 early bird rate. Electricity will increase to \$120 on August 16. *Please bring a 50'-100' extension cord to connect to hubs.* Electricians will be setting up the hubs throughout the day on Friday during setup.

## **Emergencies**

We have an EMT behind the Information Booth for minor emergencies. The Information Booth is located on the north side of Everett St, between Park Ave and 8th Ave at the center of the event. For emergencies, dial 911 first. *Please remember we are in an active urban environment and keep an eye on your valuables.*

There is also a sign up sheet at the Info Booth if you want to sign up for a specific time. We will do our best to accommodate your requests.

## **Artists Hospitality Tent**

Is located between NW Everett St & NW Flanders St in the middle of the park between the rows of artists booths, behind the Info Booth. Your artist name tag is needed for the Hospitality Tent. Coffee will be ready by 8am. Food hours 8:30am-4pm Sat & Sun and 8:30am-3pm Monday. We are planning on afternoon snack deliveries directly to your booths.

## **Dogs Are Prohibited**

Only service dogs are permitted.

#### **Load Out**

Please wait until after 4:00 pm Monday to begin packing up. Have your entire booth disassembled, then check with a volunteer in an orange vest to ensure you have clearance to bring your vehicle on site. Once you have clearance, enter at the same cross streets as your load-in checkpoint.

# RULES FOR PARTICIPATION AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY IN THE ART IN THE PEARL FINE ARTS AND CRAFTS FESTIVAL

- 1. All exhibited work must be consistent with the images submitted by Artist and selected by the jury.
- 2. All exhibited work must be original to and handcrafted by the accepted Artist. Artist guarantees the accuracy of the description of the work presented to the jury and the authenticity of the work as the creation of their own hands.
- 3. Work done by a production studio is not acceptable. All work must be designed and executed by the accepted Artist.
- 4. All participating Artists must be present with their work for the entire three days of the Art Festival. All booths and display materials must remain intact during the entire festival. Representatives may not attend in place of the artist. The Organizer reserves the right to close or remove any booth at which the Artist is not noticeably present. Acceptable photo identification is required at check-in to ensure compliance.
- 5. Artists must be at least 18 years old.
- 6. Only those Artists accepted in the Jewelry category may exhibit or sell jewelry. All jewelry, regardless of the materials used, must be entered in the Jewelry category.
- 7. Artists must prominently display an Artist Statement in their booth describing their materials, process and technique.
- 8. No more than two artists may collaborate on work. Both Artists must be included on the application. Artist collaborators that produce a single product must creatively contribute to each piece.

Art In The Pearl Inc. seeks to present the highest quality fine arts and crafts festival. Consistent enforcement of these rules helps us meet that goal. Members from the Quality Assurance Committee will visit all displays at intervals throughout the Festival. An artist may be asked to remove work. If issues are resolved, the artist may remain in the festival. If the noncompliance remains, the artist may be requested to leave the festival at that time. Such removal may also make the artist ineligible for future participation in Art In The Pearl. If an Artist is asked to leave the show for noncompliance, no booth fee refunds or other compensation will be provided.

#### RESTRICTIONS: TWO DIMENSIONAL REPRODUCTIONS

- 1. Quality, unframed reproductions of two-dimensional originals, signed and numbered by the Artist, are the only acceptable form of sales in addition to the original works. When original art is scanned in or digitally uploaded into a computer or photographed onto film and then printed as a Giclee/inkjet print, photograph, offset lithograph, photocopy etc., the result is considered a reproduction and not an original work in accordance with Festival rules. Any of the above or any similar method of work that also receives additional modification or enhancement by the Artist are also considered to be Reproductions in accordance with the Festival rules. All reproductions must be clearly and individually labeled "reproduction" on the front of each piece. They must NOT be labeled as "print", "offset lithograph" or "giclee".
- \*\*\*Reproductions on canvas are not acceptable.
- 2. Reproductions must be signed, and editions must contain no more than 250 total per image.
- 3. Reproductions shall be unframed and may not be displayed on any wall space. Only original works may be hung. Reproductions may be displayed only in browse boxes, flip bins or similar displays.
- 4. At least 85% of Artist's display shall consist of original artwork. Reproductions will be limited to no more than 15% of the total display by any Artist. Reproductions must be consistent with the style and quality of work represented in juried images.
- 5. Artists may not sell postcards, note cards, calendars, posters, magnets, stationery, works digitally printed on canvas (e.g. giclee on canvas), or tshirts.
- 6. Photographers are encouraged to do their own printing. Photographs on canvas are not acceptable. Photographic prints made from the artist's original image, which have been processed by that artist, are included in this category. Photographers are required to disclose both their creative and printing processes.
- \*\*\*All work must be signed, numbered, and dated in limited editions of no more than 250 per image\*\*\*

Signage of an overtly commercial nature listing the availability of numerous sizes, print surfaces and/or framing options is prohibited.


